CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, J. W. Richard has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Cart Spring

through open cut and reservoir for stockwatering and domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 20, T. 8 S., R. 65 E., M.D.B.&M.

situated in Lincoln County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator D. L. Stewart

Post-office address Alamo, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.0015 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 50 head of cattle

Period of use, from February 1 to November 30 of each year

Date of priority of appropriation November 19, 1917

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of an open cut and piped to a series of small earthen reservoirs located in the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 20, T. 8 S., R. 65 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
