CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Albert Silver, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from A pond through pump and pipe line for Mining purposes purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 23, T. 8 N., R. 43 E., M.D.E.&M., or at a point from which the N 1/2 Corner of said Section 23, bears N. 40° 50' E., 3,005.00 feet. situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows: Name of appropriator Fred L. Cole, Elcey Cole Williams, and Florence Livingston as executrix of the Estate of Florence L. Kirchen. Post-office address Tonopah, Nevada Amount of appropriation 2.00 c.f.s. Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year Date of priority of appropriation July 1, 1948

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: A gasoline driven pump and 300 feet of 3 inch pipe conveys the water to a placer gravel washing plant that is located within the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 23, T. 8 N., R. 43 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
