

THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Ed. S. Giles, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through well, pump, windmill, pipeline, trough for Stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 34, T. 1 S., R. 35 E., M.D.B. & M. or at a point from which the NW Corner of said Section 34, bears N. 55 1/2 W., 5,805.00 feet, situated in Esmeralda County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Rex B. Clark
Post-office address Arlemont Ranch, Dyer, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.016 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 500 head of cattle
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation September 2, 1948

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a driven well 30 feet deep, equipped with a windmill and pump. Water is pumped into a short pipeline that conveys it to a stockwatering trough located in the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 34, T. 1 S., R. 35 E., M.D.B. & M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
