

THE STATE OF NEVADA CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Paul Taddey, Rancher has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Las Vegas Artesian Basin) through well and pipelines for Irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE¹ NE¹ Section 3, T. 22 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the NE Corner of said Section 3, bears N. 29° 12' E., 1,607.60 feet situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a drilled artesian well, 565 feet deep, and equipped with a 4 inch gate valve. 250 feet of 1 1/2 inch pipe and 300 feet of 3/4 inch pipe conveys the water from the well to six apartments and 4 acres of trees, shrubs and lawn, located in Lot 1 and a portion of the SE¹ NE¹ Section 3, T. 22 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B. & M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
