CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Russell D. Smith, Motel Operator has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Underground source (Las Vegas Artesian Basin) through pump, pipelines and storage tank for General Hotel Supply and Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 16, T. 21 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the W 1/4 Corner of said Section 16 bears S. 64° 29' W., 1,331.70 feet situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
A drilled well, 312 feet deep, and cased with 302 feet of 6 1/2 inch casing. Equipped with a 1 Type Jacuzzi Bros. Inc. 3 phase 5 H.P. Pump, that is connected with a pressure system, that pumps the water into a 1,000 gallon storage tank. A pipeline system delivers the water to 36 Motel Units, Manager's House, one detached Cottage, Restaurant, Cocktail Lounge, and irrigates lawns, trees and shrubs surrounding the buildings, and all located in portions of the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 16, T. 21 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B. & M.

This certificate is issued subject to a right granted to A. J. Howd and wife to attach a one-half inch pipe line to the above named water system.
The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
