CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Fay Bresnan Kantor, Motel Operator has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Las Vegas Artesian Basin)

through well and pipelines for Quasi-municipal and domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 16, T. 21 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the W 1/2 Corner of said Section 16, bears N. 40° 32' W., 1,238.00 feet.

situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year

Date of priority of appropriation November 18, 1946

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 752 feet deep and cased with 750 feet of 8 inch casing. A pipe conveys the water to motel units, each with bath facilities. Lawns and shrubs are sprinkled with hose. The entire use is within portion of the S 1/4 NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 16, T. 21 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
