CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Vernon Young, Stockraiser has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Cow Camp Spring through tunnel, pipeline and trough for Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 1, T. 16 S., R. 59 E., M.D.B.&M., unsurveyed, or at a point from which the SE Corner of Section 36, T. 16 S., R. 58 E., M.D.B.&M., bears S. 49° 20' W., 7.75 miles situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Vernon Young
Post-office address: 300 Tonopah Highway, Las Vegas, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.000625 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 20 head of horses.
Period of use, from: January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: April 30, 1947

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a 30 foot tunnel. 1,200 feet of 1 1/2 inch pipe conveys the water from the tunnel to a cement watering trough 6 feet by 3 feet by 2 feet and located in the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 1, T. 16 S., R. 59 E., M.D.B.&M., unsurveyed.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
