CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, H. R. Jepsen, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

Sharpe Spring
through tank and pipelines for Irrigation and domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 16, T. 12 N., R. 19 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the E 1/4 Corner of said Section 16, bears N. 39° 50' E., 2,870.00 feet.

situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 128, Statutes of 1931 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.05 c.f.s.
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation October 7, 1936

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is diverted directly from the spring into an 11,000 gallon tank; thence through a 2 1/2 inch pipeline a distance of 600 feet; thence through a 2 inch pipeline a distance of one half mile to the main house where it is reduced to a 1 1/2 inch pipeline that conveys the water to a network of 1/2 inch pipelines throughout the house and grounds and all located in the S 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 16, T. 12 N., R. 19 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
