CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, W. H. Settelmeyer, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from unnamed spring through diversion box, pipeline and tank for Domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 21, T. 29 N., R. 52 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the E 1/2 Corner of said Section 21, bears N. 37° 18' E., 1,115.40 feet. situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year

Date of priority of appropriation May 10, 1943

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

diversion
Works consist of a wooden/box installed at the at the spring.
The spring area is fenced. 9,600 feet of 2 inch and 1 inch pipe conveys the water to a receiving tank 9 feet in diameter and 8 feet high. 400 feet of 2 inch pipe conveys the water from the tank to the "Hay Ranch House" located in the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 9, T. 29 N., R. 52 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
