CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Green L. Storm has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Spring Valley Creek through dam, pipeline and ditch for Mining and milling purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 35, T. 29 N., R. 34 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE Corner of said Section 35 bears S. 66° 11' E., 2,365.00 feet. situated in Pershing County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 1.00 c.f.s.
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation October 9, 1940

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is diverted from the creek by means of a small dam and conveyed by means of an 8 inch pipe and a small ditch to the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 35, T. 29 N., R. 34 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
