

To Change Point of Diversion of Application No. 10432 THE STATE OF NEVADA

CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Walter Polkinghorne has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Greggs Canyon through dam and ditch for Irrigation

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 18, T. 33 N., R. 40 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE Corner of Section 21, T. 33 N., R. 40 E., bears S. 62° 48' E., 13,855.00 feet, situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Application No. 12068 was made to change the point of diversion under Permit No. 10432 which has a priority of October 24, 1939, hence the priority of October 24, 1939 for Permit No. 12068.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
