CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Vernon E. Bunker, Partner has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from _____
an underground source (Timpiute Well)
through well, pump, storage tank and trough for _____
Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 29, T. 3 S., R. 56 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW Corner of said Section 29, bears S. 55° 00' W., 3,900.00 feet.
situated in Lincoln County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.008 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 250 head of cattle.
Period of use, from July 3 to September 16 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation September 17, 1946

Description of WORKS of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a drilled well 135 feet deep and cased with 6 inch casing. Equipped with a pumping system that pumps the water from the well into 20 feet of 2 inch pipe that conveys the water into a 20,000 gallon storage tank, thence to a cement stock-watering tank having a capacity of 600 gallons and located in the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 29, T. 3 S., R. 56 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
