CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Roy W. McVicar, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Artesian Well) through pipelines for Stockwatering and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 19, T. 11 N., R. 24 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW Corner of Section 24, T. 11 N., R. 23 E., bears N. 82° 23' W., 9,300.6 feet. situated in Lyon County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation March 15, 1948

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a drilled artesian well 120 feet deep and cased with 3 inch casing. Twenty feet of 1 inch pipe conveys the water from the well to a house, garden and stockwatering facilities all located in the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 19, T. 11 N., R. 24 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
