CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Benny Binion has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Las Vegas Artesian Basin) through pipe lines for Quasi-municipal and domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 28, T. 20 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the W 1/2 Corner of said Section 28, bears N. 5° 10' W., 815.00 feet. situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.08 c.f.s. or 27 acre feet per year
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation November 16, 1945

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a drilled well 886 feet deep, cased with 450' 7" of 10 inch casing and 886 feet of 8 inch casing. The flow of the well is controlled with an 8" and 10" combination cap and 4 inch gate valve. The free flow of the well is conveyed by means of a 2 inch pipe line to the house, trough and sprinkling system that irrigates approximately 4.50 acres located in the SW Corner of the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 28, T. 20 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
