CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Orvis Stock, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Dana-Vail Spring through collecting boxes and pipeline for Stockwatering and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 14, T. 32 N., R. 57 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW Corner of said Section 14, bears N. 58° 31' W., 1312.20 feet. situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Ella Marian L. Dana and Sidney H. Vail

Post-office address Elko, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.008 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 200 head of cattle and 60 head of horses.

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year

Date of priority of appropriation: August 31, 1940

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is collected in the spring area by means of two collecting boxes. The main collecting box is located near the lower end of the spring area and is 4' x 6' x 6'. The second box is located about 85 feet above the main box and is 4' x 4' x 6'. About 25 feet of 6 inch tile laid in gravel conveys the water to the two boxes. Approximately 5,000 feet of 3 inch welded pipe conveys the water from the collecting boxes to the house and corrals located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 10, T. 32 N., R. 57 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
