

THE STATE OF NEVADA  
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS W. T. Holcomb, State Highway Engineer has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Unnamed Spring through storage tank and pipe line for Irrigation of lawn and trees (domestic and general public use) purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 29, T. 37 N., R. 66 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the E 1/4 Corner of said Section 29, bears S. 86° 45' 10" E., 3,009.15 feet. situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year  
Date of priority of appropriation July 1, 1948

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:  
Spring developed by means of a trench 30 feet long in which was laid 20 feet of perforated corrugated metal pipe, which is connected to 30 feet of corrugated metal pipe that conveys the water to a reinforced concrete water tank 12 1/2 feet long, 8 feet wide and 9 1/2 feet deep. Approximately 1950 feet of 2 inch galvanized iron pipe conveys the water from the tank to the maintenance station including approximately 400 feet of pipe in the maintenance yard and located in the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 29, T. 37 N., R. 66 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
