CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Roy A. Brown has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Brown Station Dug Well) through pump, pipe line and trough for Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 18, T. 16 N., R. 40 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW Corner of said Section 18, bears S. 14° 12' W., 1,915.00 feet.

situated in Lander County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Roy A. Brown
Post-office address Fallon, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.0125 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 400 head of cattle.
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation January 24, 1949

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a dug well 27 feet deep and cribbed with 2 inch redwood planks. Equipped with a Pomona pump and powered by a belt from a drive wheel on a tractor. About 40 feet of 4 inch pipe conveys the water from the pump to a 1,000 gallon stockwatering trough 9 feet in diameter and 2 feet deep located in the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 18, T. 16 N., R. 40 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
