CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Floyd R. Lamb has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

Gold Spring

through pipe line and trough for

Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 1, T. 6 S., R. 52 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE Corner of Section 36, T. 4 S., R. 51 E., bears N. 48° 16' W., 54,455.00 feet.

situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Floyd R. Lamb and Carlton P. Lamb

Post-office address Alamo, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.0065 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 200 head of cattle and 10 horses.

Period of use, from June 1 to December 31 of each year

Date of priority of appropriation October 14, 1947

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

The spring is developed by means of an open cut 50 feet long and 9 feet wide with an average depth of 9 feet. A concrete box is installed at the head of the cut and 1,500 feet of 1 1/2 inch pipe conveys the water to a concrete watering trough, 10 feet in diameter and 3 feet deep, located in the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 1, T. 6 S., R. 52 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
