

THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS W. H. Settelmeyer, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from unnamed spring on the NW side of Red Mountain through dam and pond for stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 35, T. 26 N., R. 45 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE Corner of said Section 35, bears N. 89° 07' E., 1,154.00 feet. situated in Lander County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Henry Filippini
Post-office address: Battle Mountain, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.016 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 500 head of cattle.
Period of use, from: January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: May 23, 1925

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

An earth and rock dam has been constructed immediately below the spring forming a small pond that serves to water cattle and is located in the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 35; and the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 26, T. 26 N., R. 45 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
