

THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, W. H. Settelmeyer, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Red Mountain Spring No. 2 through channel leading from the spring for Stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 36, T. 26 N., R. 45 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE Corner of said Section 36, bears S. 34° 48' E., 1,345.00 feet, situated in Lander County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Henry Filippini

Post-office address Battle Mountain, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.002 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 75 head of cattle.

Period of use, from April 1st to October 1st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation June 18, 1925

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

The natural depression or channel leading in a northeasterly direction from the spring is used to water cattle and is within the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 36, T. 26 N., R. 45 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
