CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, W. H. Settelmeyer, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Red Mountain No. 4 Spring through barrel, pipeline, trough for Stockwatering

purposes: The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Lot 10, Section 6, T. 25 N., R. 46 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE Corner of Section 1, T. 25 N., R. 45 E., bears S. 13° 22' 19" W., 1,108.00 feet. situated in Lander County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Post-office address Battle Mountain, Nevada  
Amount of appropriation 0.002 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 75 head of cattle.  
Period of use, from April 1st to October 1st of each year  
Date of priority of appropriation June 18, 1925

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:  
The water of this spring is collected in a round barrel and conveyed by a pipe line to a semi-circular metal trough 4 feet across the top by 2.2 feet deep and 10 feet long and located in Lot 10, T. 25 N., R. 46 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
