CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS W. H. Settelmeyer, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

Addington or Red Mountain Spring

through pipeline and wooden trough for

Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 6, T. 25 N., R. 46 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the E 1/4 Corner of Section 6, T. 25 N., R. 46 E., bears S. 58° 20' E., 1,690.00 feet, situated in Lander County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Henry Filippini

Post-office address Battle Mountain, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.0019 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 60 head of cattle.

Period of use, from April 1 to December 1 of each year

Date of priority of appropriation September 8, 1925

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is conveyed from the spring by means of 55 feet of 1 inch pipe to a wooden trough 4 feet wide by 1 foot deep and 12 feet long located in the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 6, T. 25 N., R. 46 E., M.D.B. & M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
