CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, W. H. Settelmeyer, agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Placer Gulch Spring through dams and ponds for Stockwatering purposes: The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 23, T. 26 N., R. 44 E., M.D.B. & M., unsurveyed, or at a point from which the SE Corner of Section 25, T. 26 N., R. 44 E., bears S. 56°53' E., 11,374.00 feet. situated in Lander County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.017 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 550 head of cattle.
Period of use, from April 1 to October 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation September 26, 1925

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Several small rock and earth dams are placed in the channel leading in an easterly direction from the spring forming small drinking ponds, all located in the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 23, T. 26 N., R. 44 E., M.D.B. & M., unsurveyed.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
