

THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, W. H. Settelmeyer, agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Dry Creek Springs through bottomless troughs for Stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 3, T. 24 N., R. 46 E., M.D.B.&M., unsurveyed, or at a point from which the SE Corner of Section 33, T. 25 N., R. 46 E., bears N. 5°01' W., 613.65 feet, situated in Lander County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Post-office address Battle Mountain, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.003 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 100 head of cattle.
Period of use, from April 1 to November 1 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation October 7, 1925

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Three bottomless troughs, (a) (b) (c), are placed in the channel leading in a southerly direction from the spring in which the water rises. Trough (a) is wooden and bottomless and is 18 feet long by 1 1/2 feet wide by 2 feet deep; trough (b) is wooden and bottomless and is 16 feet long, 4 feet wide and 2 feet deep; trough (c) is metal and bottomless and is 9 feet in diameter and 2 feet deep, all located in the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 3, T. 24 N., R. 46 E., M.D.B.&M., unsurveyed.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
