

THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, W. R. Campbell has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through pump, pipe line and sprinkler system for domestic and irrigation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 20, T. 36 N., R. 38 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the S 1/4 Corner of said Section 20, bears S. 89° 14' W., 1,115.00 feet, situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation: 0.06 c.f.s.
Period of use, from: January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: October 14, 1947

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a drilled well 202 feet deep cased with 6 inch casing and equipped with a Berkeley Pump and pressure system. The water is conveyed from the pump by means of a 1 1/2 inch pipe line to a sprinkler system that irrigates 2.78 acres of garden, lawn and trees located in the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 20, T. 36 N., R. 38 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
