CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Ruth A. Saylor has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Las Vegas Artesian Basin) through well, pump and pipeline for Domestic

purposes: The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 19, T. 20 S., R. 62 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the West 1/4 Corner of said Section 19, bears N. 82° 27' 30" W., 1,459.4 feet. situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation May 2, 1945

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a drilled well 200 feet deep and cased with 6 inch casing. Equipped with a jet pump with a capacity of 460 gallons per hour. Water is conveyed from the pump by means of 100 feet of 1 inch pipe to the house, wash house and the garden and trees that surround the house, all located within the W 1/4 NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 19, T. 20 S., R. 62 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
