CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Dan L. Waite has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Dud's Spring through pipelines and tanks for Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 12, T. 15 S., R. 70 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the E $\frac{1}{2}$ Corner of Section 1, T. 15 S., R. 70 E., bears N. 43° 42' E., 5,546.5 feet. situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation August 16, 1943

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is conveyed from Dud's Spring by means of about 4516.7 feet of 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe to a point where it joins the pipeline from Seep Springs; thence by 2 miles of 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe; thence by means of 6 miles of 2 inch pipe to points where the water empties into two cement storage tanks. The first tank is 25 feet in diameter and 12 feet deep and the second tank is 15 feet in diameter and 14 feet deep. The water is conveyed from the tanks to the town of Bunkerville by means of a 2 inch pipeline with 3/4 inch outlets. The place of use is confined to portions of Sections 25 and 26, T. 13 S., R. 70 E., M.D.B.&M.

NOTE: Application No. 12842 was filed to change the point of diversion and place of use of water heretofore appropriated under Permit No. 10981 hence the priority of August 16, 1943 the date Application No. 10981 was filed.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
