CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS C. J. Lyons has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through well, pump, pipeline and tank for Irrigation, domestic & Fire Protection

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 34, T. 14 N., R. 18 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the N 1/2 Corner of said Section 34, bears N. 75° 34' 54" E., 864.14 feet, situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation July 10, 1946

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a dug well 30 feet deep and cased from the bottom toward the top with 26 feet of 48 inch corrugated iron casing thence by 5 feet of 60 inch corrugated iron casing to the surface. Equipped with an electrically driven double action steam boiler pump that pumps the water from the well through 650 feet of 1 1/2 inch pipe to a 2,500 gallon steel storage tank; thence from the tank the water is conveyed to a gasoline station, store, dwellings and garden by means of a pipeline distribution system and located in the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 34, T. 14 N., R. 18 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
