CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, W. W. Whitaker has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Derringer Well) through well, pump and trough for Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 5, T. 11 N., R. 35 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE Corner of Section 24, T. 11 N., R. 35 E., bears S. 57° 07' E., 30,124.00 feet. situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator W. W. Whitaker
Post-office address P.O. Box 32, Fallon, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.01 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 300 head of cattle.
Period of use, from October 1 to April 30 of the year following year.
Date of priority of appropriation November 1, 1947

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a drilled well 105 feet deep and cased with 6 inch casing. Equipped with a windmill and a 5 H. P. Auxiliary pump that pumps the water through 13 feet of 2 inch pipe to a steel tank 10 feet in diameter and 6 feet deep; thence by 30 ft. of 2" pipe to a concrete watering trough 5' x 16' x 2', located in the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 5, T. 11 N., R. 35 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
