

THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS C. M. Trimble has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Pollard Creek through dam and ditch system for Irrigation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 1, T. 30 N., R. 39 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the N 1/4 Corner of said Section 1, bears N. 83° 30' E., 1,310.00 feet. situated in Pershing County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator C. M. Trimble and Estella Trimble

Post-office address Winnemucca, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.337 c.f.s. or 122.11 acre feet per season

Period of use, from April 1 to October 1 of each year

Date of priority of appropriation February 11, 1939

Description of land to which water is appurtenant: 33.70 acres in the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 32, T. 31 N., R. 39 E., M.D.B.&M.

The water from Pollard Creek is co-mingled with the water from Mud Springs to irrigate the above described land and the total amount of water used from both sources shall not exceed 122.11 acre feet per season.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
