CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Frank D. Rathbun, Jr., Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Las Vegas Artesian Basin) through well, pump, storage tank, pipeline for Domestic purposes

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 32, T. 20 S., R. 62 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW Corner of said Section 32, bears N. 77° 55' W., 223.00 feet, situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation July 1, 1946

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a drilled well 500 feet deep and equipped with a pumping system consisting of a windmill and an auxiliary gasoline engine that powers a pump that pumps the water into a 2,250 gallon storage tank. The water is conveyed from the storage tank by means of 200 feet of 1 1/2 inch pipe and 100 feet of 3/4 inch pipe to a six room residence located in the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 32, T. 20 S., R. 62 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
