CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Joseph E. Metz has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Las Vegas Artesian Basin) through well, pump, reservoir, pipeline for Irrigation and Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 19, T. 20 S., R. 62 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the N 1/4 Corner of said Section 19, bears N. 5° 44' W., 2,440.00 feet, situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.008 c.f.s. or 12 acre feet per year
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation April 30, 1947

Description of land to which water is appurtenant:
2 acres in the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 19, T. 20 S., R. 62 E., M.D.B.&M.
NOTE: Water is developed by means of a drilled well 120 feet deep and cased with 8 inch casing. Equipped with a pump jack powered by a windmill and an auxiliary 1/2 H.P. electric motor. Water is pumped into a cement reservoir 15' x 15' x 28" having a capacity of 3,000 gallons. A pipe line conveys the water from the reservoir to one residence and the 2 acres of trees and garden located in the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 19, T. 20 S., R. 62 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
