THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, E. T. Nollner has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Las Vegas Artesian Basin) through well, pump, tank, reservoir, pipeline for Irrigation and Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 31, T. 21 S., R. 62 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the N $\frac{1}{4}$ Corner of said Section 31, bears N. 37° 50' 15" E., 2,097.9 feet. situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year

Description of land to which water is appurtenant:
5.00 acres in the N $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 31, T. 21 S., R. 62 E., M.D.B. & M.

NOTE: Water is developed by means of a well drilled during the year 1931 to an unknown depth and cased with 6 inch casing. Equipped with a 1 H.P. pump that pumps the water into a 100 gallon storage tank: thence by pipe lines to three houses located in the N $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 31, T. 21 S., R. 62 E., M.D.B. & M.

* This amended certificate is issued to show the correct location of the point of diversion, which was incorrectly described as being in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 31, on the original Certificate, #3492 which was recorded August 30, 1950 in Book 2, Water Appropriations at page 212 of the Clark County Records. Therefore, this amended Certificate of Appropriation of Water supercedes and nullifies said original document.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
