CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS S. H. Manor has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Laundry Spring through open cut, dam, pipeline and trough for Stockwatering

purposes: The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 23, T. 4 N., R. 38 E., M.D.B.&M., unsurveyed, or at a point from which the NW Corner of T. 4 N., R. 39 E., bears N. 30° 38' E., 18,867.00 feet, situated in Esmeralda County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.003 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 100 head of cattle and 10 head of horses.
Period of use, from November 1 to April 1 of the following year.
Date of priority of appropriation June 12, 1946

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of an open cut equipped with a concrete dam through which 40 feet of 1 1/2 inch pipeline conveys the water to a round bottom stockwatering trough, 8 feet by 3 feet with a capacity of 200 gallons and located in the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 23, T. 4 N., R. 38 E., M.D.B.&M., unsurveyed.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
