CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Constant Vener has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Willow Spring through pipe line and troughs for Stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 15, T. 6 N., R. 49 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE Corner of Section 24, T. 6 N., R. 49 E., bears S. 87° 50' E., 12,545 feet, situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Constant Vener

Post-office address Tybo, Via Tonopah, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.0035 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 100 cattle and 10 horses.

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year

Date of priority of appropriation October 11, 1947

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is developed by means of two open cuts and conveyed by means of 100 feet of 1 1/2 inch pipe to steel watering troughs located in the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 15, T. 6 N., R. 49 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
