

THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Glen L. Churchill has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Las Vegas Artesian Basin) through well, pump, storage tank, pipeline for Irrigation and Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 19, T. 20 S., R. 62 E., M.D.E.&M., or at a point from which NE Corner of said Section 19, bears N. 76° 24' E., 600 feet, situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Glen L. Churchill
Post-office address: General Delivery, Las Vegas, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.01 c.f.s. or 6.00 acre feet per year.
Period of use, from: January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: October 9, 1947

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a drilled well 125 feet deep and cased with 12 feet of 8 inch casing. Equipped with a gas engine driven Jack pump and windmill which pumps the water into a 500 gallon storage tank; thence by 25 feet of 3/4 inch pipe to the house. A hose line and ditches convey the water to 1.00 acre of trees and landscaping located in the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 19, T. 20 S., R. 62 E., M.D.E.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
