THE STATE OF NEVADA CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, E. W. Fallini has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

Hot Creek

through dam and pond for

Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 11, T. 5 N., R. 51 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE Corner of Section 7, T. 5 N., R. 51 E., bears N. 74° 00' W., 1,060.00 feet, situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Fallini Brothers

Post-office address Twin Springs, Via Tonopah, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.01 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 300 head of cattle and 25 head of horses.

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year

Date of priority of appropriation February 3, 1950

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Storm waters flowing in the channel of Hot Creek are impounded in an excavated pond 140 feet x 140 feet x 4 feet deep, located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 11, T. 5 N., R. 51 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
