CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Robert F. Guinn, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Fulton Spring through open cut and reservoir for Stockwatering and Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 30, T. 20 N., R. 20 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE Corner of said Section 30, bears N. 0° 32' W., 3,347.79 feet. situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.0019 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 20 head of cattle and 200 head of sheep
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation November 14, 1947

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Fulton Spring was cleaned by means of an open cut 20 feet long, 1 foot wide and 1 foot deep. The water that flows from the open cut is impounded in a small stockwatering reservoir created by the construction of an earthen dam across the channel leading from the spring, located in the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 30, T. 20 N., R. 20 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
