CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, H. D. Willis, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Canyon Spring through rock well, pipeline, trough for Wildlife watering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 11, T. 15 S., R. 60 E., M.D.B.&M., unsurveyed.

situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.0001 c.f.s.

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year

Date of priority of appropriation September 13, 1948

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of an excavation at the spring site and a rock well 2' x 2' x 2' was constructed for a collecting basin. 30 feet of 1 1/2 inch pipe conveys the water to a large semi-circular galvanized iron watering trough located in the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 11, T. 15 S., R. 60 E., M.D.B.&M., unsurveyed.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
