CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Arthur K. Bourne has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from McFaul Creek through collecting boxes, reservoir, pipelings for Irrigation, domestic and fire protection purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 11, T. 13 N., R. 18 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the N 1/2 Corner of said Section 11, bears N. 66° 51' W., 886.00 feet, situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use, from: January 1 to December 31 Domestic April 1 to October 1 Irrig. of each year

Description of land to which water is appurtenant:
16.96 acres in the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 15, T. 13 N., R. 18 E., M.D.B. & M.
7.74 " " " NE 1/4 NW 1/4 " " " " "
0.08 " " " SW 1/4 NW 1/4 " " " " "
24.78 acres total.

NOTE: A concrete collecting box has been installed at the point of diversion; thence by 9,100 feet of 4 and 3 inch pipe to two redwood settling boxes each 10' x 6' x 6', located in the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 15, T. 13 N., R. 18 E.; thence through 6,000 feet of 3 inch pipe to the residential area located in the W 1/2 SW 1/4 Section 15, T. 13 N., R. 18 E. where it is used for general domestic purposes from January 1 to December 31 of each year.

The excess water from the redwood boxes overflows into a reservoir created by a dam across the channel of McFaul Creek and covered by Permit No. 9014; thence by 4,000 feet of pipe of varying size to the irrigated land. The combined use from all sources for irrigation purposes shall not exceed 4 acre feet per acre per season in order to conform with the duty of water set forth in the McFaul Creek Decree.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
