CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Marie Anderson has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Brown Station Spring through pipe line and trough for Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 24, T. 25 N., R. 29 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW Corner of said Section 24, bears S. 72° 01' W., 3,912.00 feet, situated in Pershing County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Post-office address Lovelock, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.016 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 500 head of cattle.
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation September 26, 1947

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is conveyed from the spring by means of 200 feet of 3 inch pipe and 200 feet of 2 inch pipe to a stockwatering trough 16" x 12" x 16', located in the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 24, T. 25 N., R. 29 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
