

THE STATE OF NEVADA CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Jerry R. Jacobs has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Cottonwood Spring through ditch, pump, pipeline, tank for Irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows, SW¹/₄ SW¹/₄ Section 22, T. 16 S., R. 71 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW Corner of said Section 22, bears S. 51° 24' W., 1,599.00 feet. situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Description of land to which water is appurtenant:
4 acres in the SE¹/₄ SW¹/₄ Section 22, T. 16 S., R. 71 E., M.D.B.&M.
3 acres in the SW¹/₄ SW¹/₄ Section 22, T. 16 S., R. 71 E., M.D.B.&M.
7 acres total.

NOTE: Water flows from the spring through 200 feet of concrete ditch and 6" and 8" pipe to a pond 65' x 40' x 6'. A Fairbanks pump with a 1 1/2 inch discharge pumps the water through 65 feet of 2 inch pipe to a 13,000 gallon storage tank; thence to house and garden plot. 100 feet of 6 inch, 150 feet of 4 inch, 500 feet of 3 inch and 2,000 feet of 2 inch pipe conveys the water from the pond to a sprinkler system that serves to irrigate the above named area.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
