CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Jack M. Steele has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through well, pump, pressure system, pipelines for Domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 34, T. 14 N., R. 18 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the meander corner of Sections 27 & 34, T. 14 N., R. 18 E., bears N. 19° 36' 53" E., 1,088.10 ft. situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.008 c.f.s.

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year

Date of priority of appropriation September 28, 1949

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a drilled well 58 feet deep and cased with 6 inch casing. Equipped with a syphon jet centrifugal pump powered by a 1/3 H.P. Electric Motor that pumps the water into a 30 gallon pressure tank; thence to the house and lawn located in the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 34, T. 14 N., R. 18 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
