CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, James M. Daniels has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Emigrant Spring through open cut, pipeline and trough for Stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 16, T. 1 N., R. 37 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the U.S.C.&G.S. Bench Mark No. 6145 on Emigrant Pass, bears S. 5° 20' W., 7,030.00 feet, situated in Esmeralda County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.011 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 250 head cattle & 100 horses.
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation December 7, 1946

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Emigrant Spring is developed by means of 35 feet of open cut from which 75 feet of 1 1/2 inch pipe conveys the water to a metal trough, 1' x 2' x 12', located in the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 16, T. 1 N., R. 37 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
