

THE STATE OF NEVADA CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Harry H. Hughes, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Jackson Spring through dams, collecting pond, pipe & trough for Stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW¹ SE¹ Section 19, T. 2 N., R. 40 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE Corner of Section 31, T. 3 N., R. 39 E., bears N. 54° 30' W., 35,375.00 feet, situated in Esmeralda County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

 Amount of appropriation 0.0034 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 100 head cattle & 10 horses.
 Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
 Date of priority of appropriation September 10, 1947

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
The spring was cleaned and four small dams have been constructed across the channel leading from the spring. Three of these dams are 4 feet long and 2 feet high and the fourth dam is 10 feet long and 2 feet high. 150 feet of 1 1/2 inch pipe conveys the water from the last dam to a sheet iron stockwatering trough 4' x 4' x 1 1/2' deep, and all located in the SW¹ SE¹ Section 19, T. 2 N., R. 40 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
