CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Harry H. Hughes, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Ethiopian Well) through well, pump, tank and trough for Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 31, T. 3 N., R. 39 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE Corner of said Section 31, bears S. 46° 30' E., 2,743.00 feet, situated in Esmeralda County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.0034 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 100 head cattle & 10 horses.
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation October 6, 1947

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a well equipped with a gasoline engine driven rotary pump that discharges into a 300 gallon tank and a 75 gallon stockwatering trough connected to the tank with a pipe and float valve, and located in the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 31, T. 3 N., R. 39 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
