CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Melvin A. Robison has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Monitor Well No. 4) through well, pump and storage tank for Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 20, T. 18 N., R. 47 E., M.D.B.&M., unsurveyed or at a point from which the NE Corner of Section 5, T. 18 N., R. 47 E., bears N. 7°06' W., 18,139.00 feet. situated in Lander County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Lenard D. Robison & Melvin A. Robison doing business under the name of Monitor Livestock Company

Post-office address Austin, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.06 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 2,000 head of cattle.

Period of use, from September 15 to June 15 of the ~~year~~ following

Date of priority of appropriation November 3, 1945

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a drilled well 140 feet deep and cased with 6 inch casing. Equipped with a pump jack powered by a windmill and an auxiliary 2 H.P. Gas Engine. Water is pumped from the well into a 10,000 gallon storage tank that serves as a stockwatering trough. The overflow from the tank is conveyed to an earthen reservoir 50 feet long, 40 feet wide and 5 feet deep that also serves to water livestock. Tank and reservoir are both located in the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 20, T. 18 N., R. 47 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
