CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, E. W. Fallini has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Reveille Mill Spring through open cut, pipeline, tank, pond for Stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 28, T. 2 N., R. 50 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE Corner of said Section 28, bears N. 47° 02' 10" E., 3,470.73 feet. situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Fallini Brothers (E.W., R.A. & Joe B. Fallini)
Post-office address Twin Springs, Via Tonopah, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.032 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 1,000 cattle and 25 horses.
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation May 15, 1950

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Reveille Mill Spring has been developed by means of an open cut 120 feet long, 3 feet wide and varying from 2 feet to 12 feet in depth. 8,500 feet of 2 1/2 and 1 1/2 inch pipe conveys the water to an iron storage tank 8 feet in diameter and 2 1/2 feet deep; thence to a dirt pond, 60 feet long, 50 feet wide and 2 feet deep located in the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 22, T. 2 N., R. 50 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
