CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, William J. Johnstone, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Emigrant Well) through well, pump and trough for Stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 11, T. 17 N., R. 23 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE Corner of said Section 11, bears S. 39° 21' E., 2,337.00 feet, situated in Lyon County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Breakaheart Ranch (R. H. Conklin)
Post-office address Dayton, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.010 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 300 head of cattle.
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation January 2, 1946

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a dug well 4 feet in diameter. Equipped with a portable Briggs-Stratton Model N.P. pump and gasoline engine. The pump discharges the water into a concrete stockwatering trough 3' x 10' and located in the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 11, T. 17 N., R. 23 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
