CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Robert A. Allen, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an un-named spring through collecting box and pipe line for Domestic and Fire Protection purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 12, T. 14 N., R. 18 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW Section Corner of said Section 12, bears N. 58° 42' 30" W., 3,666.54 feet, situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 128, Statutes of 1931 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.178 c.f.s. or 80 gallons per minute.
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation December 4, 1936

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is collected by means of a 2' x 2' x 2' redwood box installed at the spring; thence by approximately 1,300 feet of 2 inch pipe to a junction; thence by means of approximately 230 feet of 2 inch pipe to the Nevada Highway Maintenance Station. Approximately 820 feet of 2 inch pipe, equipped with stand pipes installed at regular intervals for fire protection, conveys the water from the junction to the Ski Hut where it is used for domestic purposes and the irrigation of surrounding lawns. The Nevada Highway Maintenance Station and the Ski Hut are both located in the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 12, T. 14 N., R. 18 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
